



# Bible Study Guide

## Introduction/Schedule

A study designed for individual, household, and Care group worship. Additionally, this study will prepare our households to hear God's voice as the sermon is preached weekly.

This study can be implemented in various ways. The members of each household can study individually and then discuss together the things they are learning. Another approach is for the members of the household to answer the questions together. While the study is divided into different days, any given household might choose to complete the study together in one sitting.
